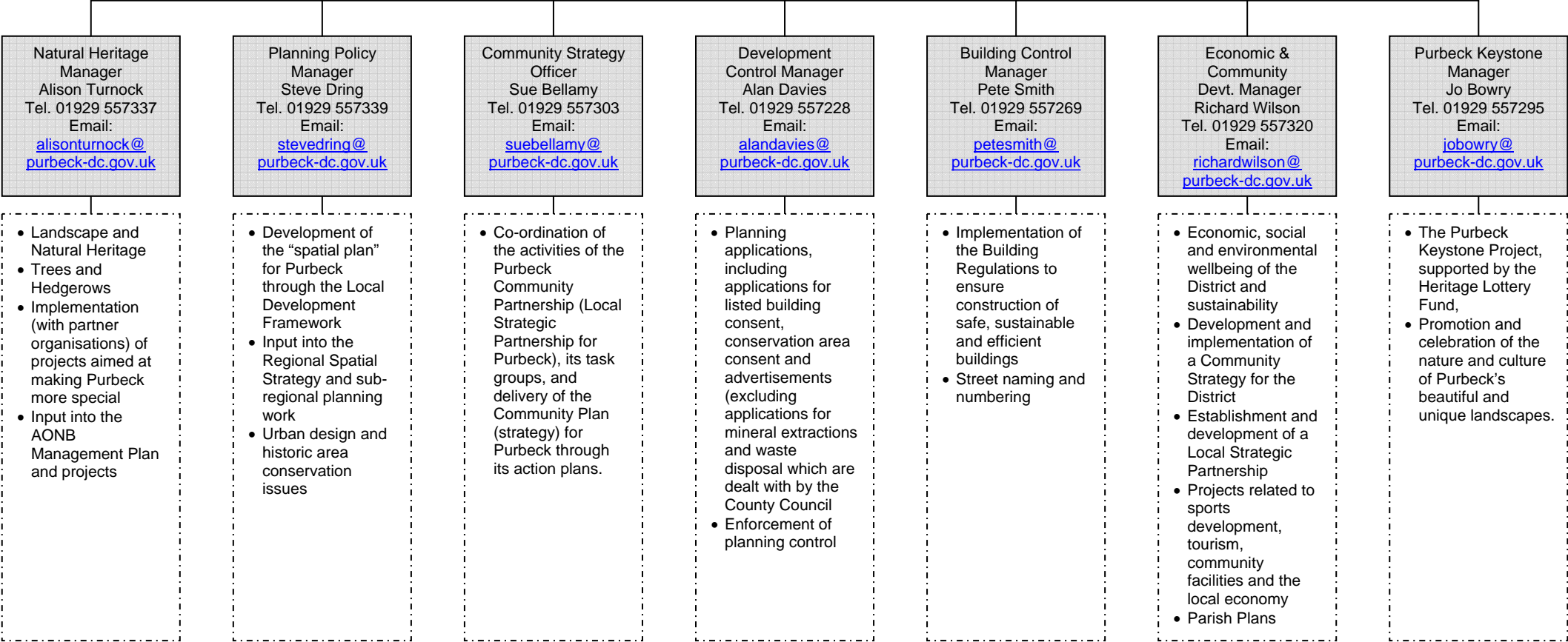
DEPARTMENTAL STRUCTURE TO BE CLARIFIED IN FEBRUARY 2010 VERSION OF CONSTITUTION

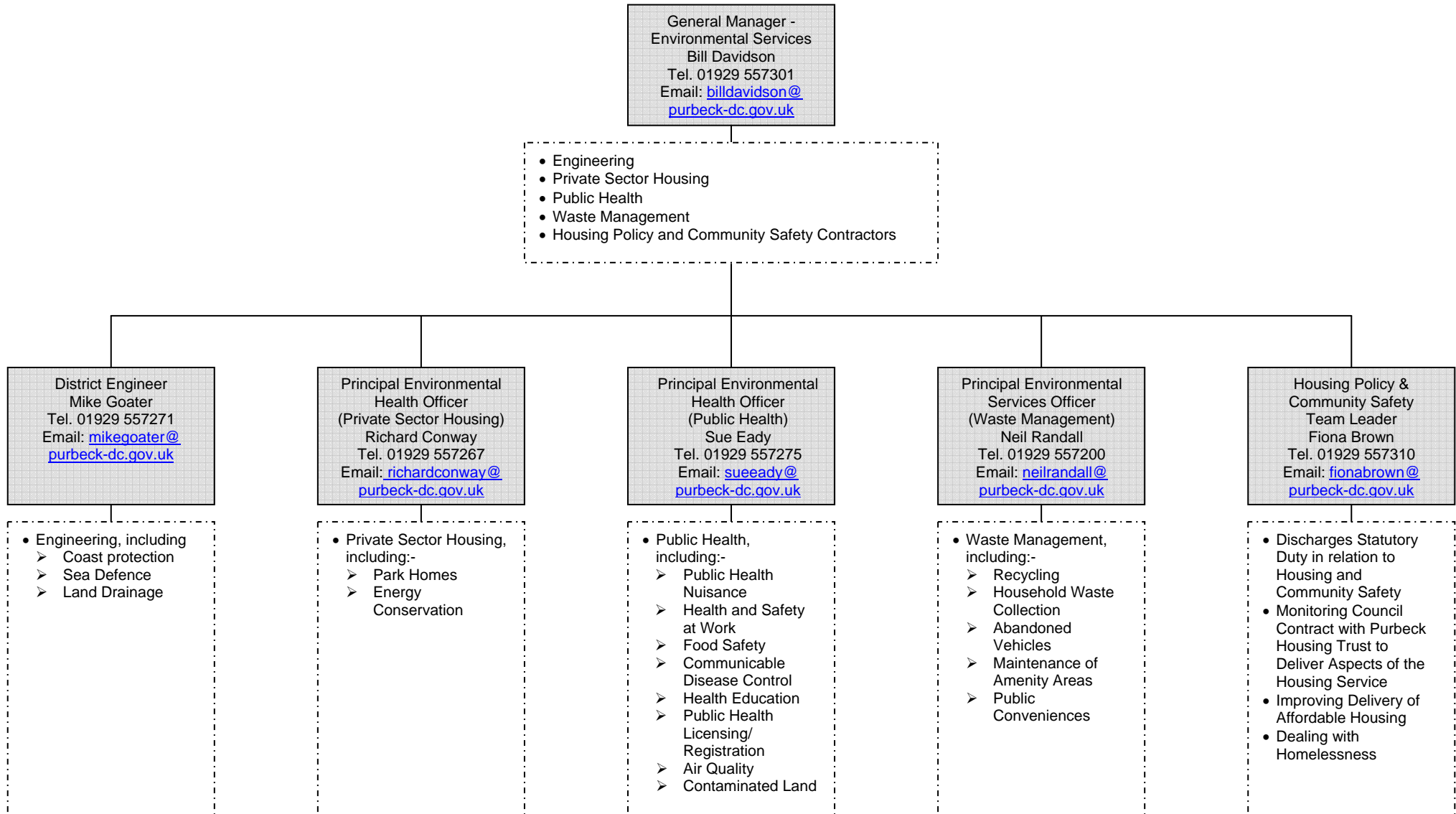
